Colorado is an all-mail ballot state which means your ballot that you vote on, and cast will be mailed to you on October 11, 2024. You may drop off or mail your ballot which you have inserted in the envelope provided to you and the envelope must be signed and dated by you. If you have not received your ballot by October 18^{th,} please call the County Clerk's office (970) 854-3131 to apply for a replacement ballot.

Early voting means that you can come into the County Clerk's office located at 221 S. Interocean Ave., Holyoke, CO and vote on a machine at the <u>VSPC</u> (Voting Services Polling Center) if you decide to forego voting the ballot that you received in the mail. The VSPC will be open 8-4, M-F beginning October 21st and November 05, 2024, 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM Election Day.

You may still register to vote and receive a ballot in the mail up to October 28th.

Please note that the mail is no longer sorted in Holyoke, that it goes to Denver and then back to Holyoke. If you plan to mail back your ballot from the Holyoke Post Office, it must be mailed no later than October 30th to get back to the County Clerk's office by November 05. Post marks are not acceptable as a return date.

For your convenience there are two 24/hr. drop boxes located at the Haxtun Town Hall, 145 S. Colorado Ave., and in Holyoke across the street from the east parking lot of the County Courthouse. Ballots will be picked up until 7:00 P.M. on election day November 05, 2024.

Ballots can not be forwarded. If you have moved you will need to get your address changed as the postal services can not forward your ballot to you, it will come back to the County Clerk's office as undeliverable. You can change your address or register to vote online up to the 28th of October. Govotecolorado.gov. You may also go to the County Clerk's office up to 7:00 PM on election day, November 05, 2024.
