#### **Appointments**

Hofmeister made a motion to approve the request from DHS Director Lori Lundgren to move Aleah Buccelli to HS Grade 68 Step 3, effective February 1, 2023. Timm seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The board tabled the revisions to the Building Permit form until further information can be researched.

The board discussed the Own Resources financial assurance for oil and gas operators to provide for plugging wells.

Timm made a motion to renew the County's Pro 15 membership and authorize payment of the 2023 membership dues of \$466. Roberts seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

The board discussed the possibility of having an appreciation dinner for members of Phillips County regional boards.
