

Project Announcement

US 6 and US 385 Bridge Replacement Project

The Colorado Department of Transportation and contracting partner, WW Clyde, will begin replacing five bridge structures located on US 6 and US 385 starting in early March. By replacing aging bridges, this project will enhance safety for Colorado's traveling public and address the challenges posed by deteriorating infrastructure. The anticipated completion date of the project is October 2026.

Bridge structures that will be replaced in 2025:

Structure B-27-DA on US 6, east of County Road 37, Mile Point 453 Structure B-27-EA on US 385, south of Colorado Highway 23, MP 279 Structure A-27-AA on US 385, south of CR 4, MP 291

Bridge structures that will be replaced in 2026:

Structure B-27-AA on US 6, west of CR 41, MP 454 Structure B-27-FA on US 6, west of CR 43, MP 455

Traffic Impacts

- Daytime work hours range from 6:30 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday
- There will be a speed reduction of 25 MPH throughout the construction zone
- To maintain traffic flow during construction, shoo-fly detours will be built at each replacement site, allowing motorists to bypass active work zones
- A 12-foot width restriction will be in place
- Construction vehicles will be entering and exiting the work zones
