



## US 385 Holyoke Resurfacing & ADA Ramp Project

### PROJECT OVERVIEW

Starting in early April, the Colorado Department of Transportation will begin an infrastructure and accessibility upgrade project along US Highway 385 north of the City of Holyoke. The main scope of work includes milling, resurfacing, widening shoulders and adding safety features to a ten-mile stretch of US 385. Other work includes installing new ADA-compliant curb ramps along US 385 and US 6 in the City of Holyoke.

### SCHEDULE & LOCATION

The project will begin in early April with the installation of ADA curb ramps. This work is expected to last until late June. After July 5, work will be focused on the resurfacing of US 385 which is expected to last until late October.

The project is located on US 385 from Mile Point 278.43 to MP 289, just over a ten mile stretch of two-lane highway extending north of Holyoke in Phillips County. Work will be performed during daylight hours Monday to Friday with some weekend work expected.

### TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Sidewalk closures will exist during curb ramp work, with pedestrian detour routes in place. Access to businesses and residences will be maintained. Alternating single lane closures will be in place in both directions of US 385 during the resurfacing phase. Pilot cars will be present to direct alternating traffic flows during single lane alignments. Construction devices, reflective cones and signs will exist to maintain safety. All construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change.
