A ballot question listed as an "amendment" proposes a change to the Colorado constitution, and a ballot question listed as a "proposition" proposes a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes. A "yes/for" vote on any LUNCH TO ALL PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENTS WHILE ALSO ballot question is a vote in favor of changing current law or existing circumstances, and a "no/against" vote on INCREASING WAGES FOR EMPLOYEES WHO PREPARE any ballot question is a vote against changing current AND SERVE SCHOOL MEALS, HELPING SCHOOLS USE law or existing circumstances. BASIC, NUTRITIOUS INGREDIENTS, INSTEAD OF

School District Ballot Measures

Haxtun School District RE-2J Referred Ballot Issue 5A

WITHOUT INCREASING TAXES, SHALL THE EXISTING VOTER-APPROVED MILL LEVY OF HAXTUN SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. RE-2J, SCHEDULED TO EXPIRE AFTER TAX COLLECTION YEAR 2027, BE EXTENDED THROUGH 2037 (FOR COLLECTION IN 2038) WHEN THE TAX WILL SUNSET, IN ORDER TO RESTORE A PORTION OF THE DISTRICT'S FUNDING, PRIOR TO THE CUTS IMPOSED BY THE STATE, WHICH MONEYS SHALL BE USED FOR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES TO INCLUDE, AMONG OTHER THINGS,

- ATTRACTING AND RETAINING HIGH-QUALITY TEACHERS,
- REPLACING OUTDATED TEXTBOOKS,
- UPDATING TECHNOLOGY, INCLUDING HARDWARE, SOFTWARE, AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS, AND
- IMPROVING ENERGY EFFICIENCY, ENHANCING SAFETY, AND EXTENDING THE USEFUL LIFE OF EXISTING SCHOOL FACILITIES, INCLUDING ROOF REPAIRS, INSTALLATION OF HVAC CONTROLS, AG SHOP UPGRADES, PLAYGROUND IMPROVEMENTS, REPLACEMENT OF BLEACHERS AND REPLACEMENT OF OUTDATED BUSES.
