US 385 Holyoke Resurfacing Project In-town Lane & Street Closures - Sept. 25 to Oct. 6

Travel Advisory

Starting on Monday, Sept. 25, and lasting for up to two weeks, crews will close alternating lanes in both directions of U.S. Highway 385 from Johnson St. to the Phillips County Event Center during in-town milling and paving operations. Temporary side street closures (except Gordon & Kellogg) and on-street parking restrictions will also be in place. Emergency access will be maintained.

Traffic Impacts

- Alternating lane closures will be in place in both directions of US 385 from Johnson St. to the Phillips County Event Center (see map)
- The closures will be taken from 6:30 a.m. to 7 p.m. weekdays from Sept. 25 to Oct. 6 during in-town milling and paving operations
- Crews will start at the north end (Phillips County Event Center) and work their way south over the two-week period
- Flaggers, signs and construction devices will be present to manage alternating traffic flows
- Temporary side street closures from Johnson to Bignel (except Gordon and Kellogg) will also exist during working hours
- Gordon and Kellogg will remain open at all times
- On-street parking will be temporarily restricted during this work
- Emergency access will be maintained
- This schedule is weather dependent and subject to further change
